# Finding Funding

- Use University funding databases
- Sign up for notices from funding agencies (NSF, grants.gov)
- Use filters to target notices to your research interests
- Talk to colleagues; look at funding sources of related research



## You Have an Idea and Found a Solicitation...

- Eligibility
  - University
  - You
- Due dates
- Budget Limit
- Duration
- Cost Share
- Does it *really* fit your idea?

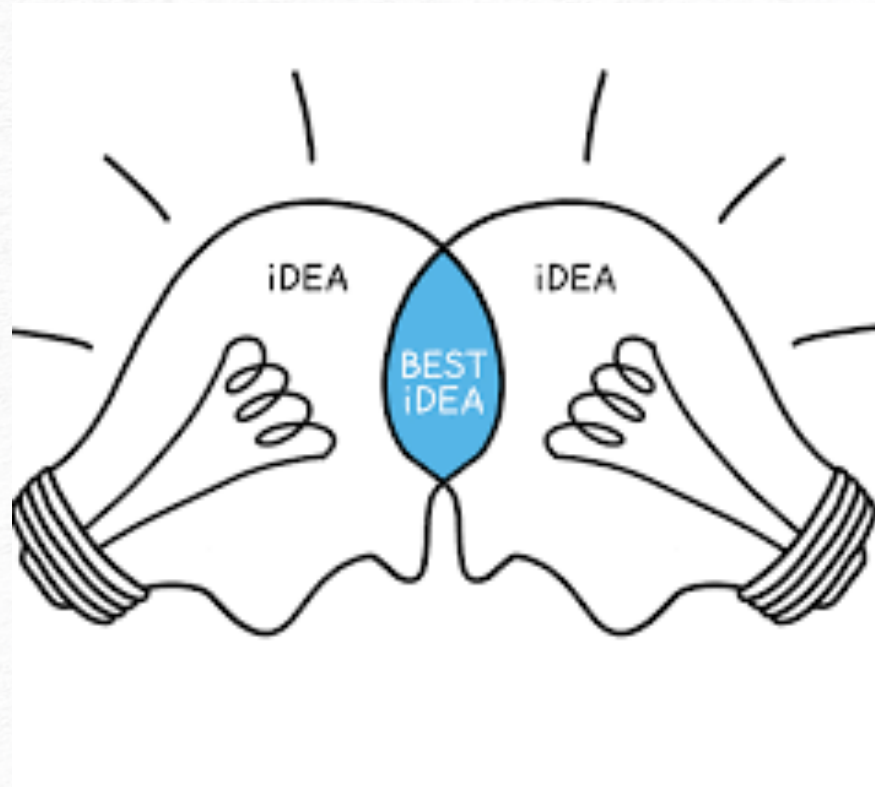
## **Broader Impacts (NSF)**

- Full participation of women, persons with disabilities, and underrepresented minorities in STEM
- Improved STEM education and educator development at any level
- Increased public scientific literacy and public engagement with science and technology
- Improved well-being of individuals in society
- Development of a diverse, globally competitive STEM workforce
- Increased partnerships between academia, industry, and others
- Improved national security
- Increased economic competitiveness of the United States
- Enhanced infrastructure for research and education



## Effective Collaboration

- Important for solving complex problems
- Takes more time and planning
- Requires great communication skills
- Must commit to the project and the team
